To celebrate the 100th Anniversary of Scouting in Chattanooga, the Cherokee Area Council offers you the chance to open a virtual time capsule: Reserve now your copy of “The History of Chattanooga Scouting,” a never-before-chronicled history of Chattanooga’s Boy Scouts, authored by local Eagle Scouts. All proceeds will support the preservation of Scouting’s history in Chattanooga.

The written history includes a complete documentation of past 100 years of Scouting in Chattanooga, a detailed account of the all summer camps, a full history of Talidandaganu’ Lodge, and a list of all Eagles, Silver Beavers, Woodbadgers, and Vigils! Join the Cherokee Area Council today in a journey through the mysteries of its own history:

- How close did the Chattanooga Council come to being a military organization for boys?
- Which troop really *is* the oldest in the area?
- Why did an early Scout Executive strike a deal to get juvenile delinquents off probation so they could join the Scouts?
- What troubles did Scouting experience before World War I, and does history repeat itself?
- How did a boy earn the first summer camp patch in 1919?
- Was there really Lone Scouting in downtown Chattanooga?

To complement this written history, an 2-gigabyte flash drive chock-full of photographs, flyers, newspaper articles, and other documents serves to flesh out Scouting’s history in a way that no written history can accomplish.
