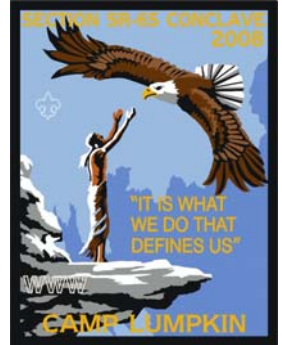
sure to attend the Spring Fellowship to get ready for this competition).
